
Trinity Symbols

There are many symbols for the Trinity. Do you see any of them in your worship space today? If so, draw it in the space below. If not, design your own!










- Today is **Trinity Sunday**.





















Some of the words from these memory verses got switched! Can you help them find the right spot? Draw a line from each bold word to its correct spot in the other verse.
